Text is typed using 12 New Time Roman fonts, line spacing 1.15. The text area is A4 paper size, 11.5 cm wide and 22 cm high, including headers and footers. For example, (Kowalski, 2014).

**Writing the script**

Prepare your text at least six pages and a maximum of 14 pages (if possible), including references. Font size and format, as shown in table 1 with the letters Time New Roman. Margin: Upper 30 mm, bottom 30 mm, right 35 mm, and left 35 mm. For example, (Lin, Regenstein, Lv, Lu, & Jiang, 2017). We recommend that the authors use the IMRAD (Introduction, Method, Result and Discussion) method for laboratory research.

The number of references is at least 15 articles with reference to the minimum of the last five years from the year of submission. Updated articles as much as 50% of the number of references cited.
